
SAY This is the answer sheet you will use during today's test. Use your answer sheet to record your answers to the multiple-choice questions.

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SAY For multiple-choice questions, you must mark your answers on your answer sheet by darkening the circle for the letter that matches your answer. Only the answers marked on your answer sheet for the multiple-choice questions will be scored. Use only a No. 2 pencil. If you make a mistake on your answer sheet, erase your mistake completely and darken the circle for the letter that matches your answer.

For written-response questions, you must write your answers directly in your test booklet in the space provided. You may not use additional paper for your answers. Only the answers written in your test booklet will be scored. Write your answers clearly and legibly. If you make a mistake, erase it completely or draw a line through it. Use only a No. 2 pencil. You may not use a pen or highlighter to record any of your answers.

When you see the words GO ON at the bottom of a test booklet page, go on to the next page. When you come to the word STOP, you have reached the end. You may go back and check your work. When you are finished please place your answer sheet inside the front cover of your test booklet and close your test booklet.

Are there any questions?
